THANKING GOD WHEN I AM LEFT WITH SHATTERED PLANS, THAT HE HAS BETTER PLANS

²¹ After they had gone a long time without food, Paul stood up before them and said: "Men, you should have taken my advice not to sail from Crete; then you would have spared yourselves this damage and loss. ²² But now I urge you to keep up your courage, because not one of you will be lost; only the ship will be destroyed. *Acts* 27:21-22



THE BACKSTORY

When Paul was placed on this ship headed for Rome—he knew that part of his life and ministry was directed by the sovereign will of God.

- » Acts 21:10-11 tells of a prophecy Paul received saying that if he went to Jerusalem, he would be taken prisoner, then be turned over to Rome.
- » His friends pleaded with him not to go.
- » Seven days later, he was dragged out of the temple by a mob determined to kill him.
- » He was arrested by Roman soldiers shortly thereafter.
- » As a Roman citizen, Paul appealed his case to Caesar.
- » The appointment—to meet with Augustus Caesar was what got him in the boat.

SHATTERED PLANS

- » Paul left Caesaria.
- » Paul, other prisoners, Roman guards, Luke and others boarded a ship to Myra. (v. 5)
- » The group changed ships. They boarded an Alexandrian (Egyptian) ship headed for Rome. (v. 6-8)
- » There was a pit stop in Fair Havens, Island of Crete. The Jewish people on board honored "Yom Kippur" and fasted one day. (v. 9-10)
- » Shattered plans: they were overwhelmed by a hurricane.

 Even Paul and Luke were afraid. (v. 11-20)

- » During the storm, Paul encouraged everyone: "God will get us through this." (v. 21-26)
- » The storm got worse. Efforts were made to save the ship and people's lives. (v. 27-32)
- » No one ate for 14 days due to seasickness. Paul encouraged all to eat and stated again how God would get them through this. They listened to Paul and ate. Paul "blessed" the food as a witness to all. (v. 33-38)
- » They spotted land—Malta Island. The storm wrecked the ship, but everybody made it safely to shore. (v.39-44)

GOD HAD PLANS

Even though the captain, the centurion and Paul wanted to reach
Rome before winter, GOD HAD BETTER PLANS:

- » The 276 on board the ship were stranded on the island for three months.
- » Paul shared the gospel of Christ.
- » He healed the governor's father.
- » Upon hearing about this, many came to be healed.
- » They boarded another vessel for the trip to Rome.
- » The Malta people supplied them with all they needed for their voyage.
