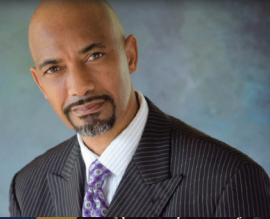

¹⁹ So Elijah went from there and found Elisha son of Shaphat. He was plowing with twelve yoke of oxen, and he himself was driving the twelfth pair. Elijah went up to him and threw his cloak around him. ²⁰ Elisha then left his oxen and ran after Elijah. "Let me kiss my father and mother goodbye," he said, "and then I will come with you." "Go back," Elijah replied, "What have I done to you." **1 Kings 19:19-20**

THE ELISHA PROFILE

- Lived during the 9th Century B.C.
- Israel was a divided nation—full of Baal idolatry.
- Worked on his family farm helping his mom/dad.
- Called by God to be a prophet.
- Trained for many years under Elijah.
- Performed miracles; counseled kings; spoke on behalf of God.

◇ THE UNEXPECTED VISIT ◇


So Elijah went from there and found Elisha son of Shaphat.

He was plowing with twelve yoke of oxen, and he himself was driving the twelfth pair.

Elijah went up to him and threw his cloak around him.

1 Kings 19:9



- 
- Elijah threw his cloak around him—it snowballed from there.
 - It was an invitation to leave the farm and be a prophet.
 - It was an opportunity to serve the senior prophet.
 - It was a pathway to serve as a counselor to kings.
 - It was an invite to perform miracles and heal the nation.

◇ THE DECISION THAT CHANGED HIS LIFE

So Elisha left him and went back. He took his yoke of oxen and slaughtered them. He burned the plowing equipment to cook the meat and gave it to the people, and they ate. Then he set out to follow Elijah and became his servant. **1 Kings 19:21**

- Elisha killed his oxen and burned his plow. It was both a statement and a direction. He was never coming back.
- He once-and-for-all eliminated anything of his past calling him back.
- **One decision forever changed the course of his life!**

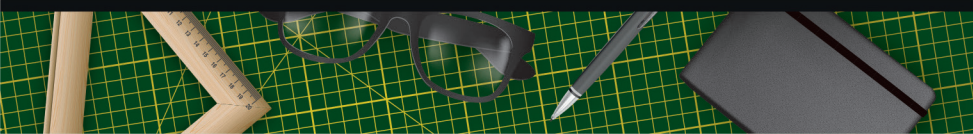
ONE DECISION HAS MADE A DIFFERENCE FOR BILLY RAY HARRIS

◇ THE IMPLICATIONS OF ONE DECISION ◇

God's directions are often intentionally vague. God will often give people one word in life so that you can move on in faith and understanding. There are two principles worth noting in Elisha's decision:

- 1 YOU DON'T HAVE TO UNDERSTAND FULLY TO OBEY COMPLETELY.**
- 2 THOSE THAT GOD USES THE MOST ARE THE ONES WHO HOLD ON TO THE LEAST.**

what is a prayer partner?

Pastor's Prayer Partners is a ministry that focuses on praying for our church, Pastor Bob, and the overall ministries of Jubilee Christian Centre. This ministry is vital to the growth and overall health of our church. Our goal is to have a core group praying consistently for the effectiveness of ministry and the Lord's favor at JCC.

what do prayer partners do?

As a Prayer Partner, you will be asked to pray daily for the pastor, the worship team, and the teachers at JCC. You will be asked to seek God's favor over JCC so that the lost can come to Christ.



why is this ministry so important?

First, Pastor Bob needs our prayers for many reasons. The pressures of ministry, the desire to maintain God's anointing, the lost in our community, etc are all reasons that Pastor Bob needs us to lift him up in prayer. Especially as he preaches each week in our services, Pastor Bob needs our prayers that the Lord will speak through him to our church. He also needs for us to pray for his family to be as strong as ever.

Second, our church members, church leadership, and overall ministries need constant prayer. We want people who come into our church to feel the presence of the Lord here. We don't want anything

to separate our church from God's power. Keeping clean hearts and close walks with the Lord is what we are after here at Jubilee Christian Centre. An active prayer life and a completely surrendered heart to God keeps our church holy, unified, and healthy.

Third, during the week, we need prayer partners to pray specifically for those without Christ to hear the message clearly. We want God to use Pastor Bob and our worship team to reach people each who don't know the Lord. This is the mission of our church and we want to see more people come to know Christ in a personal, dynamic relationship.
