And there was a woman who had had a discharge of blood for twelve years, and though she had spent all her living on physicians, she could not be healed by anyone. WE READ TODAY ABOUT A Woman WIH many issues

- She was most likely anemic, fatigued, and worn out physically. She woke up every morning with pain and went to bed with pain.
- She had financial issues as she had exhausted everything she had on doctors, treatments and who knows what other failing hopes.
- She had relational issues, too. Levitical law prohibited her from entering the temple or coming into human contact.
 She was labeled unclean.
- She was homeless, alone, isolated, abandoned, rejected, an outcast, broken, defiled and destitute. Years of shame left her broken, stripped of any self-worth and a proper identity. She may have been bitter towards God, people and life.

Her problem pushed her into the presence of God. She had sought solutions for 12 years. She made a life-changing choice. To touch the hem of his garment!

First Miracle...

She is healed.
Issue of blood dries up.
Pain is gone.
She tries to blend in.
Then Jesus puts her on the

spot: "Who touched me?"
[If it's discovered that she has broken out of her isolation, there could be serious consequences.]

Second Miracle...

She breaks the silence. She tells Jesus her story. Her sickness. Her rejection. Her determination to touch him to be healed. (Tears running down her cheeks.)
