Judges 2:7-8, Judges 2:10 (NIV) *A generation lost! Joshua's generation! In the span of a single generation, not three! And to top it all, this was a generation who had personally witnessed miraculous signs and wonders and unbelievable victories.*

Generations are **important to God:**

In traditions

Exodus 12.14 *This day shall be for you a memorial day, and you shall keep it as a feast to the LORD; throughout your generations, as a statute forever, you shall keep it as a feast*

Esther 9.28 *...that these days should be remembered and kept throughout every generation, every family, every province, and every city,*

In covenant

Genesis 17.7 *And I will establish My covenant between Me and you and your descendants after you in their generations, for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and your descendants after you.*

Leviticus 23.43 *...that your generations may know that I made the people of Israel dwell in booths when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I am the LORD your God.*

Joshua 22.28 *Therefore we said that it will be, when they say this to us or to our generations in time to come, that we may say, 'Here is the replica of the altar of the Lord which our fathers made, though not for burnt offerings nor for sacrifices; but it is a witness between you and us.'*

In testimony

Joel 1.3 *Tell your children about it, and let your children tell their children, and their children the next generation.*

Psalms 78.4 *We will not hide them from their children, telling to be generation to come the praises of the Lord, And His strength and His wonderful works that He has done.*

Exodus 34:6-7 And he passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, "The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness, maintaining love to thousands, and forgiving wickedness, rebellion and sin. Yet he does not leave the guilty unpunished; he punishes the children and their children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation.

that the enemy is out to destroy families... that society is trying to taint the concept of family that God designed for us ...that marriages are failing ...that family roles are being reversed ...that young people are having identity issues ...that people are questioning and falling away from the truth!
