# THE LAND BETWEEN

## A Table in the Wilderness

*They spoke against God, saying, "Can God spread a table in the wilderness?" Psalm 78:19*

According to most of the Israelites in the desert, the answer was "no." God can't set a table in the wilderness. Or if he can, he won't. So, what's the difference?

- *The wilderness is a fearful place to be.* Nothing but barren hills, deep valleys, and sun-baked, gray dirt that seems to go on forever.
- *The people who had trusted in their God spoke against him openly.*
- *The wilderness was a tough place to live.*

### Things that swayed their thinking—

1

#### They forgot his works

*They forgot his works and the wonders that he had shown them. In the sight of their fathers he performed wonders in the land of Egypt, in the fields of Zoan. He divided the sea and let them pass through it, and made the waters stand like a heap. In the daytime he led them with a cloud, and all the night with a fiery light. He split rocks in the wilderness and gave them drink abundantly as from the deep. He made streams come out of the rock and caused waters to flow down like rivers. Psalm 78:11-16*

#### They did not honor the covenant

*They did not keep God's covenant, but refused to walk according to his law. Psalm 78:10*

#### They did not believe in God's power and purpose

*because they did not believe in God and did not trust his saving power. Psalm 78:22*

All these things happened to them as examples—as object lessons to us—to warn us against doing the same things; they were written down *so that we could read about them and learn from them in these last days as the world nears its end.* 1 Corinthians 10:11 MSG
