Luke 13:10-17(KJV) *The Woman With a Crippling Spirit*

IT WAS AN ORDINARY DAY...

And he was teaching in one of the synagogues on the sabbath. And, behold, there was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up herself.

- The Bible says it was a spiritual issue
- She spent 18 years looking at the ground
- No eye contact
- Unable to reach things
- Looked at differently

JESUS SET HER FREE...

And when Jesus saw her, he called her to him, and said unto her, 'Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity.' And he laid his hands on her: and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.

- Jesus saw her
- Jesus called her
- Jesus healed her
- She glorifies God

OTHERS TRIED TO STEAL HER JOY...

And the ruler of the synagogue answered with indignation, because that Jesus had healed on the sabbath day, and said

unto the people, 'There are six days in which men ought to work: in them therefore come and be healed, and not on the sabbath day.'

- The rulers are upset by the miracle
- They scorn the people not Jesus

JESUS EMPHASIZES HER WORTH...

The Lord then answered him, and said, 'Thou hypocrite, doth not each one of you on the sabbath loose his ox or his ass from the stall, and lead him away to watering? And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day?'

- Jesus calls the rulers out
- Jesus sees her again-calls her daughter
- Jesus protects her with His words
- Jesus recognizes that she isn't just sick – she is bound

Some of us are doubled over with our burdens, fears, guilt, etc.

God wants to set us free from these infirmities. He sees us as sons/daughters. He sees us as important!

God doesn't care about the rules, standards, measurements, or diagnosis of this world.



The verses that follow this scripture are two parables about the kingdom of God – The Mustard Seed and the Yeast in the Bread

MISSIONS TEAM REPORT

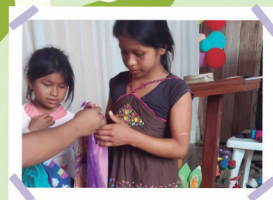
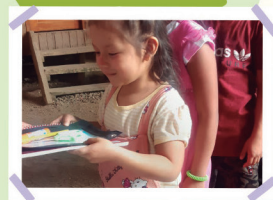
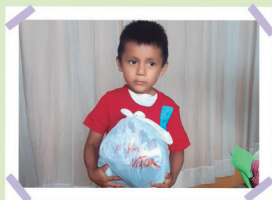
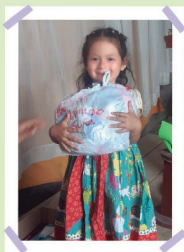

OPERATION TAISHA

[clothes/school supplies for needy kids]
