*And he had to pass through Samaria. So he came to a town of Samaria called Sychar, near the field that Jacob had given to his son Joseph. **John 4:4-5***

- He took the road less traveled.
- He went to a “forbidden” place.
- Jesus had a divine appointment with this woman.
- They meet at Jacob’s well.
- He was looking for her.

JESUS KNOWS ALL

Our Secrets

Jesus said to her, “Go, call your husband, and come here.” The woman answered him, “I have no husband.” Jesus said to her, “You are right in saying, ‘I have no husband’; for you have had five husbands, and the one you now have is not your husband. What you have said is true.” The woman said to him, “Sir, I perceive that you are a prophet.”

- Jesus knew about her shame, her doubts and fears.
- He knew her life story but did not use it to embarrass her or put her down.
- This woman had a bad reputation. She wasn't accepted by other women in town.
- She begs the question: What is it like to be exposed, in all or sin and shame, in the presence of a holy God—**It's safe!**

JESUS COMES NOT TO

Judge but to Save

For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. John 3:17

- He didn't expose her to embarrass her or shame her or judge her; he exposed her to save her.
- John says that Jesus was full of grace and truth. This was the glory of God.
- Nobody was more righteous and pure than Jesus. He always told the truth about sin; he never compromised the commandments of God—and yet, he drew in those whose lives were filled with mistakes and compromises and sin. He was full of grace and truth.

- All this woman's life she's been searching. Searching for something to numb the empty longing; something to take away the shame. 5 husbands in, she hasn't found it.
- Jesus asks her to go get her husband. That shines the light on her situation—she is on a repetitive maze and she is unsatisfied.
- Jesus calls you, like he called this woman, to follow him. Accepting Jesus is not a blind leap into the dark, as many critics love to say, it's a step into the light.

MISSIONS TEAM REPORT

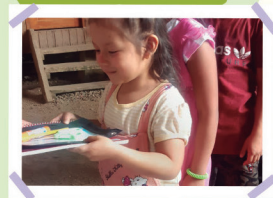
