Shout the Holy Name

Seven words for praise in Hebrew

- 1. Hallal: to praise; to celebrate; to rave.
- 2. Yadah: to throw out the hand; to lift up the hands.
- 3. Towdah: thanking God (with the hands) for things not yet received.
- 4. Barak: to kneel down; to bless God in adoration.
- 5. Zamar: to pluck the strings of an instrument joyfully.
- 6. Tehillah: to sing joyful hymns or songs to God.
- 7. Shabach: a loud declaration; a shout of triumph.



Shout the Holy Name

"One generation shall praise (shabach) Thy works to another, and shall declare Thy mighty acts." Psalm 145:4

"Because Thy lovingkindness is better than life, my lips shall praise (shabach) Thee." Psalm 63:3



You, God, are my God, earnestly I seek You; I thirst for You, my whole being longs for You, in a dry and parched land where there is no water... Because Your love is better than life, my lips will glorify You. I will praise (shabach) You as long as I live, and in Your name I will lift up my hands. Psalm 63:1-4

Praise the Lord, all you nations. Praise (shabach) Him, all you people of the earth. Psalm 117:1

Shout, (shabach) and sing for joy, O inhabitant of Zion, or great in your midst is the Holy One of Israel. Isaiah 12:6

What does shabach look like? Joshua 6

Joshua led the Israelites to conquer Jericho-

First, they marched around the walls in silence for six days.

On the seventh day, they circled the walls seven times.

As they circled the seventh time, they were instructed to 'shabach'

A MIGHTY SHOUT

The loud outcry collapsed the walls of Jericho and brought them victory.

They shouted in triumph already, even though they hadn't completely taken over the city.

They claimed the victory through a joyful shout of FAITH!

God is showing us how to move into our victory in faith through a joy-filled shout.
