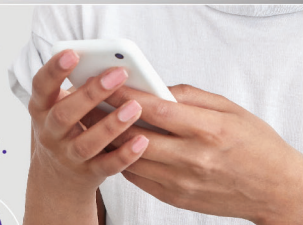

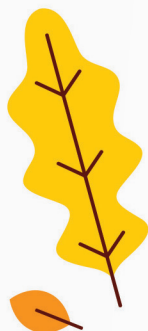

Lamentations is Jeremiah's journal about the hard times. Jeremiah had just witnessed the wrath of God poured out in undiluted concentration upon his nation.

- Their armies had been defeated, their defenses overwhelmed, their riches pillaged.
- All their cities were looted and burned; their men killed, their women and children taken captive and enslaved.
- Most of those who remained alive had suffered mass resettlement with forced marches for 1,000s of miles to a foreign country where they were settled among people who hated them.
