### Exaltation

The Lord promised the children of Israel that if they should hearken or listen and obey his commandment, then he will exalt them above all the nations of the earth.

### Prosperity

The Lord promised the Children of Israel that when they obey his commandment then "blessed shalt thou be in the field... and the fruit of the ground, and the fruit of thy cattle... blessed shall be thy basket and thy storeroom.



**Victory** The Lord said unto the Israelites, "The Lord shall cause thine enemies that rise up against thee to be smitten before thy face: they shall come out against thee one way, and flee before thee seven ways"

**Head and not the Tale** - The head is the part of the body that makes the decision, while the tale is dragged around.

**Fruitfulness** Children are a heritage from the Lord (Ps 127:3) and is therefore seen as a blessing.

**Health** Sickness is not of God (though at times he will afflict you with sickness when you do not obey the Lord).

## The Ten Lepers

It has been said that there could not be a disease more devastating to a person living in Palestine in the first century A.D. than leprosy.

### Lepers cry out to Jesus

*On the way to Jerusalem he was passing along between Samaria and Galilee. And as he entered a village, he was met by ten lepers, who stood at a distance and lifted up their voices, saying, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us."* **Luke 17:11-13**

### Jesus gives them a healing word

*When he saw them he said to them, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." And as they went they were cleansed.* **Luke 17:14**

### A thankful respondent

*Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice; and he fell on his face at Jesus' feet, giving him thanks. Now he was a Samaritan.* **Luke 17:15-16**

### Jesus asks the defining question

*Then Jesus answered, "Were not ten cleansed? Where are the nine? Was no one found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?"* **Luke 11:17-18**

### The thank-you blessing

*And he said to him, "Rise and go your way; your faith has made you well."* **Luke 11:19**
