NAMAAN HAD A SKIN DISEASE-LEPROSY

- » He was declared to be "unclean".
- » This condition compromised his entire future.
- » He could never fit in—would always be separated from the movers & shakers in Syria.



GOD'S FIRST WITNESS FOR THE MIRACLE

- » No flash of light from heaven.
- » No majestic prophet announcing an answer to Namaan's needs from on high.
- » No angelic visitation.
- » We are told that during a border skirmish, one of the Syrian bands captured a young Israeli girl and brought her to Namaan who made her his wife's servant.
- » As a Jew, she had every reason to shun Namaan and to stay her distance from him.
- » Instead she approaches Namaan's wife and pleads that Namaan could be completely cured of his leprosy if only he would go and see the prophet of the God of the Jews in Samaria.

NAMAAN'S RESPONSE



- » After all, he is a man of power!
- » He wants a fancy letter of introduction; about \$150,000 in cash, and ten designer suits cut to fit the King of Israel
- » He sets off to the place of the miracle.







GOD'S SECOND WITNESS FOR THE MIRACLE

- » Namaan wanted special treatment...
- » He arrives at the king's court. The king is shaken that Namaan has asked him to have the prophet heal him. He has wrong expectations!
- » Mysteriously, Elisha sends a messenger to the king to have Namaan call on him.
- » Namaan travels to the prophet's home.
- » No fanfare. There is no welcome wagon.
- » There is no meal offered. No red carpet rolled out
- » The servant goes out and tells him to jump in the lake (river) seven times.
- » He was angry over where the miracle would happen!
- » Namaan is seething—his dignity has been assaulted and all protocol has been by passed!
- » It's hard to know how much more crudeness Namaan can take.

GOD'S THIRD WITNESS FOR THE MIRACLE

- » Here is someone that Namaan knows very well.
- "if the prophet had asked you to do something really special or hard or difficult-some great thing, then you would have done it, wouldn't you. Elisha is asking you to do something simple, so easy, and yet so hard for a man like you. All you have to do is come to the Jordan and wash. Not one time, but seven times."

So he went down and dipped himself in the Jordan seven times, as the man of God had told him, and his flesh was restored and became clean like that of a young boy. 2 Kings 5:14
