#### **JESUS REVEALED HIMSELF**

#### AGAIN...(FOR PETER'S SAKE)

- · Peter made a fool of himself.
- Displayed lots of BRAVADO—

"Even if all those losers forsake you, I never will."

- When Jesus was arrested, Peter stood around a fire and two teenaged girls embarrassed him.
- "Hey are you one of Jesus' disciples?"
- · "Never heard of him."
- · So after the third time he was asked.
- The rooster crowed!
- · You think—that's it...God's plans for me are over.

#### SIMON PETER GOES FISHING AGAIN

- He was depressed over his failure.
- Some other disciples went with him.
- They fished all night and caught nothing.
- As day was breaking, Jesus stood on the shore.
- The disciples didn't know it was him.
- Jesus said, "Cast your nets on the right side of the boat and you will find some."
- · When they did, they caught a net full of fish!
- Peter is told it is the Lord standing on the shore.

#### PETER DOES WHAT HE DOES

#### **BEST: PERFORMANCE**

When they got out on land, they saw a charcoal fire in place, with fish laid out on it, and bread. Jesus said to them, "Bring some of the fish that you have just caught." So Simon Peter went aboard and hauled the net ashore, full of large fish, 153 of them. And although there were so many, the net was not torn. John 21:9-11

## PETER'S FOUR DEADLY SPIRITUAL CONDITIONS

Peter's pride and confidence in his abilities kept him in some deadly spiritual conditions:

- It made him unsure of his relationship to God—have I done enough?
- It left him spiritually weak because his own sense of strength kept him from depending on Jesus.
- It kept Peter self-focused—on how well he's doing.
- Unable to help others in weakness.
