THE KING'S PRESENTS

¹ After Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, during the time of King Herod, Magi from the east came to Jerusalem ² and asked, "Where is the one who has been born king of the Jews? We saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him. *Matthew 2:1-2* ◆

// The Wise Men >> Seek The Newborn King The structure is pretty simple...

wise men looking for Jesus based on a "new" star that has led them. They arrive looking for the king (Herod); their arrival caused a stir and caused panic in Herod's court. The question: "Where is he that is king of the Jews?"

>> 25. 3-6 Herod was disturbed; he asked the priests and scribes where the Messiah was to be born, they told him it was in Bethlehem because of the prophesy of Micah.

Herod called the wise men to find out what time the star had appeared and informed them that they should report back to him so he could also worship. Herod's intent was evil.

The wise men followed the star that led them to the child and to Mary. When they arrived, they presented their gifts and went back by a different way—because they had been warned in a dream.

The First Christmas » Gifts

On coming to the house, they saw the child with his mother Mary, and they bowed down and worshiped him. Then they opened their treasures and presented him with gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh.

Matthew 2:11 ←

- They presented him with the gift of gold. Gold is mentioned 358 times in the Bible.
- It was a treasure befitting royalty or deity. Represented real wealth.
- He was given the gift of frankincense. It speaks of prayer. Incense is offered only to God. It speaks of His deity and divinity.
- Frankincense symbolizes prayer accepted before God.
- They presented him with the gift of myrrh. Myrrh was used for embalming bodies. It represented wealth.
- Myrrh spoke prophetically of sacrifice.

A Preview Of What's To Come

- The wise men are the first to pay homage to the King of the Jews.
- According to Philippians 2, "every knee shall bow in heaven and in earth, and every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father."
- According to Revelation 4, " ¹⁰ the twenty-four elders fall down before him who sits on the throne and worship him who lives for ever and ever. They lay their crowns before the throne and say: " "You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they were created and have their being."
