16 This is what the LORD says—he who made a way through the sea, a path through the mighty waters, ¹⁷ who drew out the chariots and horses, the army and reinforcements together, and they lay there, never to rise again, extinguished, snuffed out like a wick: ¹⁸ "Forget the former things; do not dwell on the past. ¹⁹ See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland. *Isaiah 43:16-19*

On the eve of their release from Babylonian Captivity, Isaiah encourages the captives to trust God for "new things." He reminds them that God is in control and that captivity was purposeful, but now He has great plans for them as they return to Israel.

GOD EBAAL-ZEPHON

Isaiah paints a word picture of God the Waymaker. He makes a reference to Israel's crossing of the Red Sea when they were pinned in at Baal-Zephon.

» God's plan most often is hard to understand.
Why would God take Israel to a cul-de-sac in the desert,
then inspire Pharaoh to reclaim his recently moved-out slaves?

- » When God is up to something things get CHAOTIC.
 - » Israel was panic-stricken when Pharaoh gave chase and was closing in on them.
- » God's plan was unique: he called them out so that He could confront all of Egypt's might and in one mighty blow destroy them forever.
 - » He wanted His people to see how he deals with those that take His people captive. It is not pretty!
- » He not only lured Pharaoh to the Red Sea but took him out—forever!

DON'T DWELL ON SE PAST

If we want to be led to a new place, Isaiah gives an instruction—

"don't dwell on the past."

- The past can be a trap in which we get stuck when we linger over it.
 - The past can be a place of instruction, not a compass for the future.
 - The past can become our fantasy life if we allow it.
 - The past can rob us of our present joy if we replay the wrongs that others have done to us.

NEW ROADS & NEW RIVERS

spoken by God to His people in Isaiah 43. He spoke a faith-path out of their seventy-year captivity into liberation and redemption. God was calling His people out from the old and into the new. He was calling things that were not as though they had already. happened. As far as God was concerned, it was already a done deal.

God is promising to do new things-

- To carve out new pathways in the face of overwhelming odds.
- To do the unexpected in spite of the circumstances
 - To show Himself strong in what looks like an impossible situation.
 - To bring good out of so many missteps.
 - To provide in totally unforeseen ways.
