For the moment, there are no activities, only meetings by video calls with the ministries in which I serve.

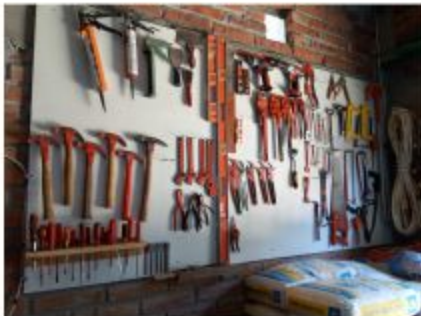
