Kindred desires to be available to provide support in the planning and


coordinating of the weddings and memorial services of its members, which are held at Kindred. For more information contact the church office.

who are not able to participate in-person in the ministries of the church stay connected with the church family. Our goal is to maintain regular and consistent contact with homebound members through in-person visits, telephone calls, and other means of connection.



Hospital Visitation

The goal of the Hospital Care Ministry is to provide personal care and connection with

Kindred members currently admitted to the hospital (and or in a rehab facility). Personal care is expressed through consistent individual visits, phone calls, notes, and other forms of connection.

This is a ministry focused on helping widows find joy and purpose after the loss of a spouse. This

group meets for lunch the first and third Tuesday of each month for encouragement, fellowship, and support.
