### Medication

If your student will be bringing medication they need to take while at camp, it must be given to and kept by our camp nurse.

Please clearly label all medication with your student's name, dosage, etc., and package all of it in a Ziploc bag labeled with your student's name.

Parents must connect with our camp nurse at check-in the day we leave for camp to go over all medication so that we can take the best care of your student.

All medication will be given or administered by our camp nurse.

### In Case of An Emergency

Every activity sponsored by Kindred Community Church is carefully planned and adequately supervised by mature adults. However, even with the best of planning and precautions, unforeseen events can occur.

In case of an emergency, we will attempt to contact the person listed on your student's KSM Release Form as soon as possible to make the best possible decision for your student's well-being and safety.

### In Case of Sickness or Injury

If your student gets sick while at camp or is injured, we will contact the person listed on your student's KSM Release Form as soon as possible.

If necessary, we may ask that a parent or guardian come pick up your student from camp.

## CHECK-IN AND RETURN

### **Check-In:**

We will begin check-in for camp on June 23rd at 8:00 AM at our Student Ministries facilities. (130 S. Chaparral Ct. Suite 130, Anaheim CA, 92808)

When you arrive, our team will help you navigate our check-in process. Parents will be directed to our JH room for check-in while their students are guided over to our HS room to take care of their luggage. Once your student has been checked in, they are all set! You can hopefully still make it over for service on campus.

### **Departure:**

## RULES LIST
