Medication

Check-In:

RULES LIST

1.) You are not allowed into the cabins of the opposite sex. Stay out of the area of the other sex's cabins

2.) Be aware of where and when the next activity is happening. Do not be late.

3.) Cell phones are not allowed to be used throughout the camp except at designated times given by camp leaders. If you *need* to use your phone you must ask a leader.

4.) You must listen to the instructions of any leader.

5.) Respect the campground's facilities; treat it as if it were your own. If you break something, report it to the Youth Pastor or Junior High Director immediately.

6.) Do not leave the campground at any time.

7.) Winter camp is not the time or place to find a significant other. Allow camp to be a time to pursue one person: The Lord.

8.) All pranks must be approved by the Youth Pastor. If a prank is pulled without his approval, your parents will be contacted and you will be sent home.

RULES - TECHNOLOGY

1.) The following devices are not allowed at camp unless given explicit permission from the Student Ministries pastor:

- Laptops
- ipads
- Airpods / headphones / etc.
- Ipods / mp3 players

2.) If any of these devices are used or found during camp, leaders will confiscate their devices and will be given to the Student Ministries Pastor to be returned to the student's PARENTS upon returning to KSM after camp.

3.) Phones - We are strongly encouraging all student not to bring their phone to camp but to be truly distraction-free. If parents decide that their student can bring their phone to camp, it will be with the following conditions:

- Phones will only be allowed up at camp during designated times specified by our group (Free time, before bed to call parents, etc.).
- Phones are only allowed to be used to take pictures during these designated times with friends or to call their parents.
- Phones will NOT be allowed to be used on the buses.
- Phones will NOT be allowed to be used to text other students up at camp.
- Phones will NOT be allowed to be used for social media, music, games, texting, or accessing any other apps during camp.
- Phones will NOT be allowed to be used for note taking or as a Bible (students should bring a hard copy Bible and Notebook

4.)
