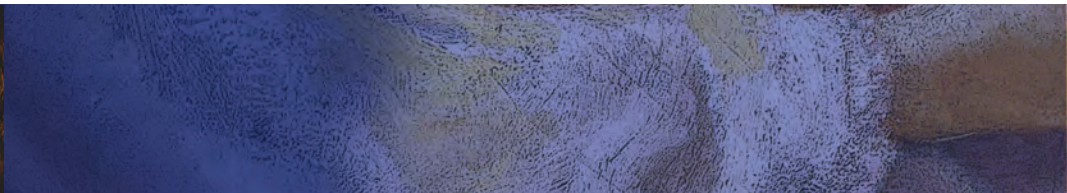

"The Lord is My Friend" is an original violin piece composed by Gage Galutia as part of a Confirmation faith project, inspired by John 15:13.

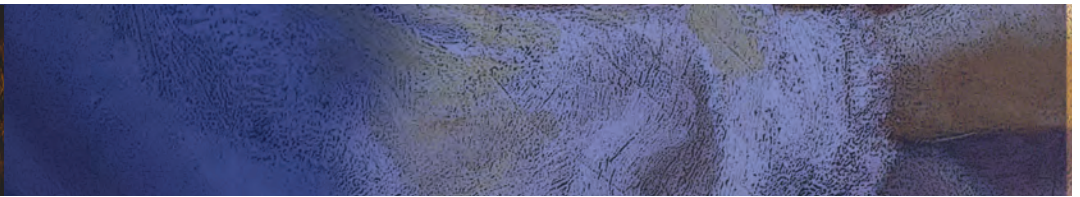

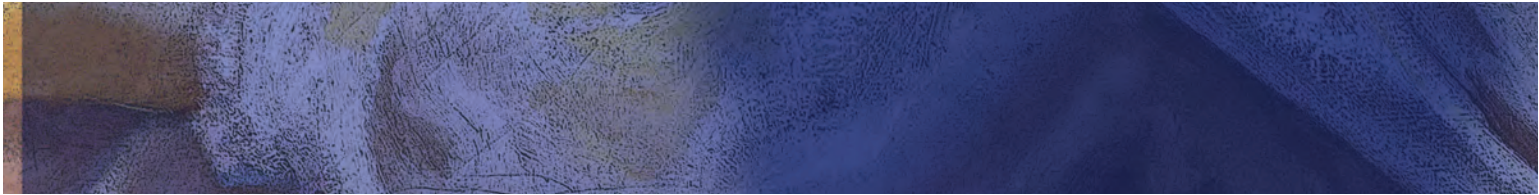
