#### THROUGH OUR HUNGER RELIEF MINISTRIES

Thank you to our entire congregation for helping us serve our neighbors! Because of the generosity of our church we are able to provide a basic need—food—to children and families in the surrounding area. Our food pantry assists with two efforts throughout the school year.

### BACKSNACK PROGRAM: FEEDING LOCAL CHILDREN

Deena Schneider works with Resource Officers at two local schools to identify children who need food each weekend. Meals are planned, purchased and packed each week. Then, with the help of Curt Henke and Billie Westervelt, packed food is delivered every two weeks, serving 20 children between the two schools.

#### **HOLIDAY MEALS**

Thanksgiving and Christmas meals are always an invaluable experience to appreciate our blessings and serve our neighbors. Working with Resource Officers at five local schools, we are able to identify families who need holiday meals. With the help of Junior Youth, we buy, pack and hand out 25 full meals per holiday. These meals are accompanied with prayer from our church family.

A VERY BIG thank you to Deena Schneider for her leadership, time and love that she gives to our hunger relief ministry. She and her family spend hours each week meal planning, shopping, purchasing and packing meal bags.
