PURIFICATION OF MARY & PRESENTATION OF JESUS

Mary and Joseph came to Jerusalem after Mary's time of purification in order to present Jesus and to redeem him according to the law of Moses (Leviticus 12). They brought with them the offering of the poor—two turtledoves.

Jesus, born of a woman and born under the law (Galatians 4), would be the once and for all Offering to redeem those who are under the law. Presented here to the temple priest as a baby, Jesus would at last present himself to God as both priest and sacrifice for us.

Upon their arrival, a righteous elderly man named Simeon takes the infant Jesus into his frail arms and prays: Lord, let your servant go in peace. Your Word is fulfilled, for I have seen your salvation: a light for all nations and the glory of Israel! Simeon is consoled because he knows the Lord has kept his promise.

For centuries, Lutherans have spoken or sung Simeon's prayer at the conclusion of the Lord's Supper. And what better words are there to confess? Just as Simeon held Jesus in his hands and praised God for his salvation, so too we, having just held Jesus in our hands, thank God for the same salvation.


