MEMORIAL GARDEN FEATURES

- Christ-centered final resting place for members
- Quiet location for friends and family to pray and meditate, on church grounds
- Up to three granite columbarium structures will be securely installed against the North wall of the Welcome Center
- Each columbarium measures 4ft. wide x 5ft. high and offers 20 niches—each having ability to hold two urns of cremated remains
- Each niche will be enclosed by a granite cover, engravable with loved ones name and dates
- Benches will provide areas for reflection
- Landscape will beautify area and church overall
- A Board of Trustees will be appointed to oversee the administration and maintenance of the garden

PHASE I - Initial Columbarium

OPEN LATE 2024

COST: \$12,000-\$15,000

Placement of one columbarium, and two benches on the North side of the Welcome Center.

PHASE II - Additional Columbariums

ESTIMATED 2026-2029

COST: \$25,000-\$30,000

An additional two columbariums will be added, bringing our total to 60 niches + extended patio and seating.

PHASE III - Beautification

ESTIMATED 2026-2029

Beautify the front grounds of the church to create a true memorial garden and place for reflection and prayer. Rendering is only a sample of potential beautification.

The Memorial Garden Committee will be requesting approval to move forward with this project at the February 18th Voters Meeting. Thanks to a generous donation of \$32,000, Phase I and much of Phase II can proceed without additional funding.
