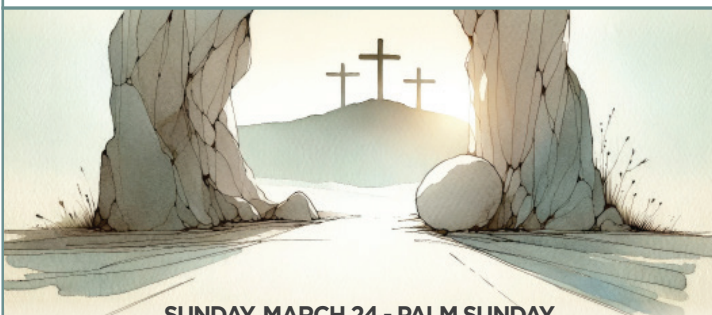

## BEWARE OF TEXT SCAMS

Please be aware of scams that may be sent through text or social messenger services. Texts from unknown numbers may even use a name from someone you know, including someone from church. These suspicious texts are likely a hoax or an account has been compromised. King of Kings pastors, staff nor members will ever ask for financial assistance through one of these channels. Churches and church members across the country are a target for these type of scams. Stay alert for "bad actors" posing as fellow church members or friends. You can often tell it is a hoax immediately by checking the number, noticing spelling errors or finding formal greetings and names. Consider taking the following precautions for all online usage:

- Utilize two-step authentication when offered.
- Use a strong, unique password for each site.
- Change your passwords regularly.
- Always use private internet connections.
- Keep your social media accounts private.
