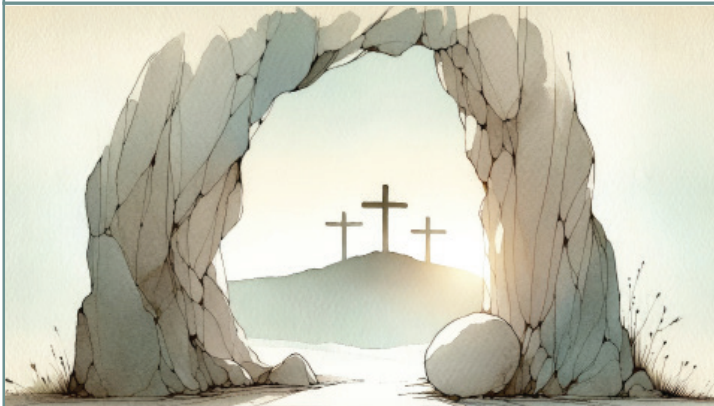
ERIN MACKENZIE
