A WORD FROM PASTOR FRANK

Remember, how He told you?

My father went to heaven last year. It was late autumn, and I visited twice. Once, to see him while he was sick. Once to mourn him when he had died. And like I did when I was a teenager, I borrowed his keys. I took his truck up and down the country roads and highways where I grew up. I passed by the old schoolhouses, and the homes of old friends. I saw new things that weren't there 30 years ago, and remembered things that I had long forgotten.

In the Gospel reading for Easter, angels appear to Mary Magdelene and the others. These servants of God seem surprised that the women were even there. "Don't you remember?" they asked. "He told you that He would rise on the third day." The women were frightened and confused; so, I guess you can't blame them for being a little forgetful. After all, Jesus had told them so many things over the years. And they had come to this place to see Him in his tomb, to say their goodbyes.

But then, they did remember. They remembered that Jesus had predicted this, but they didn't understand it at the time. They remembered that He said this was necessary, but they didn't want to believe it. And now, it was coming true. And the memory of His death on the cross, the cruel fate delivered by the soldiers, was giving way to the joy and hope of a blessed reunion with their Lord. The eager anticipation that they would look Him in the eyes once again, and rejoice that He lives!

The blessed hope of Easter is that our Lord is risen indeed, Alleluia! And because He lives, we will live with Him forever. We look forward to the day that we see Him face to face, just like the disciples found Him later in Galilee. And not just Him, but all those who have departed before us in the faith. And on that day, we will remember. We will remember that our Lord Jesus promised all this to us. At times we didn't understand it, and sometimes we could hardly believe it. But it will become true. The truest thing we have ever experienced. The fear and confusion of death in this world will give way to joy and peace in the life to come.

Week 8: Church Governance


BIBLE STUDIES RETURN


EARLY LEARNING CENTER ENROLLMENT CONTINUES 2025/2026 SCHOOL YEAR
