Just prior to Holy Week, we hosted our first-ever Global Mission Sunday. Jenny Crouch gave a moving presentation on child sponsorship through Compassion International, a 70-year old church-based ministry that brings hope to children in extreme poverty by meeting practical needs and sharing the good news about Jesus. Members from our parish family have generous hearts and signed up to sponsor 30 children in Guatemala. This is incredible! There are 5 more children needing sponsorship – please prayerfully consider being a sponsor to one of these children.

Pastor Frank's sermon shared details of how God is putting people and connections in place here at King of Kings and in Guatemala for this ministry. Our congregation plans to send around a dozen short-term missionaries to serve alongside one of our sister churches in summer of 2024. Please pray for guidance and support of this ministry.
