# MLA RECEIVES RECOMMENDATION FOR ACCREDITATION

Congratulations to Martin Luther Academy who recently received the recommendation for (re)accreditation through National Lutheran School Accreditation (NLSA). MLA hosted a 6-person review board and provided evidenced-based self-study documentation covering seven standards areas. The review board found Outstanding Strengths in:

- Close, family-like community culture •
- Authentic dedication, compassion and support of staff
- Strong leadership and Christian care from admin
- Positive, supportive and collegial relationships between MLA and association churches

Overall, MLA scored a 3.2 in accreditation. The national average is 2.75, with only 2-5 schools receiving a score greater than 3. Way to go MLA!
