Apple Bundt Cake

(from Lauren Allen, Tastes Better from Scratch)

Cake Mix:

3 cups all-purpose flour 1 tsp baking soda 2 tsp ground cinnamon 1/2 tsp ground nutmeg 1 tsp salt 2 large apples, peeled, cored and sliced 1 Tbsp lemon juice 3/4 cup oil (vegetable or canola) 1-1/2 cups sugar 1/2 cup light brown sugar 1/2 cup unsweetened applesauce 1/3 1-1/2 tsp vanilla extract



Cream Cheese Layer:

8 oz cream cheese 1/3 cup powdered sugar 1/2 tsp vanilla extract 1 large egg

Cream Cheese Layer:

Beat cream cheese until smooth. Add powdered sugar, vanilla and egg. Mix until smooth. Refrigerate.

Prepare cake:

1 large egg

- 1. Grease and flour 9" or 10" bundt pan.
- 2. Preheat oven to 350° F.
- 3. Whisk together dry ingredients. Set aside.
- 4. Toss diced apples in lemon juice. Set aside.
- 5. Mix together wet ingredients, then add dry ingredients. Add apples at the end. Don't over mix.
- 6. Pour half the batter into bundt pan. Spoon cream cheese mixture in a center line. Spoon remaining batter on top.
- Bake in preheated oven 60-75min. Cool 5-10min before inverting onto wire rack. Once cooled, drizzle with caramel sauce. Cut, serve and enjoy!
