- **BAKE SALE:** Donations of your favorite baked goods are needed. To ensure freshness, drop-off baked goods on Friday, October 10, or early on October 11.




MEANINGFUL IMPACT MADE THROUGH CONFIRMATION SERVICE PROJECT
