Each year, we partner with Samaritan's Purse International Relief to deliver Christmas shoe-

boxes filled with gifts to children around the globe. In the last 30+ years, this ministry has distributed over 220 million shoeboxes to children in need at Christmas, sharing God's love and the Good News of Jesus through a simple shoebox.

HERE'S HOW TO PARTICIPATE

FIND A SHOEBOX. Pick one up at church TODAY or use one that is average-size cardboard or plastic shoebox.

2 CHOOSE A RECIPIENT. Decide if you will purchase for a boy or girl and what age range (ages 2-4; 5-9; 10-14).

PACK YOUR BOX. Start with a WOW item (a doll, a ball, a stuffed animal, musical instrument, etc). Then add personal care items, crafts and activities, and a toy. Don't forget to add a personal note and photo. **Do not include candy, food, toothpaste, lotions, war-related items, or breakable items.

PRAY. Pray for the child receiving the box.

DONATE. Help cover shipping by donating \$10 per shoebox online or by donating cash for shipping, through the Calvin family — Jennifer, Matt, Shelby or Hailey. **Do not pack inside shoebox.
