Beginning in the 1850s, women of The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod (LCMS) started local auxiliaries to meet the needs of people and funding mission endeavors at home and abroad. In 1942, LCMS established the Lutheran Women's Missionary League (LWML). The group is now called Lutheran Women in Mission.

BOXES DUE NOV. 13

We are partnering with *Samaritan's Purse International Relief* to deliver Christmas shoeboxes filled with gifts to children around the globe again this year. Shoeboxes filled with small gifts are sent to children in the developing nations of Africa, Asia and Latin America. Since 1993, this ministry has distributed over 188 million shoeboxes to children in more than 160 countries around the world at Christmas, delivering God's love through a simple shoebox.

HERE'S HOW TO PARTICIPATE

- FIND A SHOEBOX. Start with an average-size cardboard or plastic shoebox.
- **2 CHOOSE A RECIPIENT.** Decide if you will purchase for a boy or girl and what age range (2-4; 5-9; 10-14).
- 3 PACK YOUR BOX. Start with a WOW item (a doll, a ball, a stuffed animal, musical instrument, etc). Then add personal care items, crafts and activities, and a toy. Don't forget to add a personal note and photo. **Do not include candy, food, toothpaste, lotions, war-related items, or breakable items.
- 4 PRAY. Pray for the child receiving the box and their family.
- **5 DONATE.** Help cover shipping by donating \$9 per shoebox online or by placing a check made to "Samaritans Purse" in Carla Brown's mailbox. **Do not pack inside shoebox.
- TURN IN YOUR BOX ON SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 13.
 Helpers will be available to accept shoeboxes, assist in adding labels and collect shipping donations.

DART BALL LEAGUE FORMING


BEGINNING OCTOBER 27
