Questions for Family Discussion or Personal Reflection

- 1. If God was not spirit—if he was bound by time and space—there would be negative consequences for the world he created and for us personally. Can you think of one way in which your relationship with God would be impacted drastically if God was not spirit?
- 2. Sometimes it is hard for us to accept our own inability to be everywhere we want to be and to do everything that needs to be done. How does the knowledge that God is not bound by our same limitations comfort you? Try to think of specific instances in which you feel inadequate and are being called to trust God's unlimited spirit to work.
- 3. **For Parents**: Are there ways in which the doctrine of God being a spirit could be a comfort to your child? Consider times when they may need to know that God is near both to calm their fears and to convict of secret sins.
