Questions for Family Discussion or Personal Reflection

- 1. What are some of the "sufferings of this present time" that you, your family, your neighbors, and the world are currently experiencing? How do these forms of suffering make you feel?
- 2. According to Romans 8, what is the secret to living with *hope* and *joy* through these times of suffering? How can you help one another to apply these truths over the coming weeks? Try to be creative!
- 3. **For Parents**: Share with your children some instances in which God directly answered your prayers for relief from suffering and instances in which he didn't. How have you seen God use both instances in your life for your good and for his glory?
