Questions for Family Discussion or Personal Reflection

- 1. Why was it important for Paul to "reason with them from the Scriptures?" How does Paul's approach to sharing the gospel often differ from ours? What hinders us from using the Word of God as our primary evangelistic tool?
- 2. How does Jesus' death and resurrection personally affect you? (Look at Romans 6:3-11) What would it mean for humanity if Jesus hadn't died? If he hadn't risen?
- 3. **For Parents:** Continue your discussion about the gospel from last week. Use this opportunity to call your children to repentance and belief in the risen Savior. If they express belief and a desire to follow Jesus, lead them in praying to God. A sample prayer can be found on the back of this worship guide.
