Call to Worship:

Psalm 100.1-5

Leader: Make a joyful noise to the LORD all the earth!

**People: Serve the LORD with gladness!
Come into his presence with singing!**

Leader: Know that the LORD, he is God!
It is he who made us, and we are his;
We are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.

**People: Enter his gates with thanksgiving,
And his courts with praise!
Give thanks to him; bless his name!**

His steadfast love endures forever,
And his faithfulness to all generations

Conviction of the Gospel:

1 Corinthians 8.4b-6

...we know that “an idol has no real existence,” and that “there is no God but one.” For although there may be so-called gods in heaven or on earth—as indeed there are many “gods” and many “lords”—yet for us there is one God, the Father, from whom are all things and for whom we exist, and one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom are all things and through whom we exist.
