Colossians 2:4-23 Lesson 3

Do a first reading and **Circle** all the "in Him" and "with Him"...amazing (underline any other repeated phrases)

V 4- What is the **this** referring to? See V 1-3

I-Who is the "no one"...repeated again later? (problem in Galatians and other churches Paul was involved in)

I-What is the meaning of **delude** and **plausible?** (look at the Amp translation...helpful)

A-Your turn- what application questions come to your mind when you see this... personally or generally?

V 5- Why is Paul rejoicing?

I- How would we describe "good order and firmness of the faith"? Check other translations?

Who do we have faith in?

I- How can we be with others in spirit (1 Thess. 2:17)

A- How can we encourage others in their faith? How can we encourage our pastors?

(Eph 6:11,13, 1 Cor. 15:58 (love this verse)

V6 Therefore... because of what - see V2-3, what are we to do? How are we to do it?

I- How did we become believers?

I- What does it mean to "receive" something"?

A- In your own thinking, what does it mean to "walk"? How would we do that as a Christian?

V7 How are we able to be **rooted** and **built up** and **established**? 2Tim:3:16-18

I- Why are we abounding in thanksgiving? What does abounding mean?

Optional A- Take one of those verbs (root, build, establish) think through or look up references in your concordance and find verses that would fit here. You might want to draw a picture that helps you describe what that word means, especially you gardeners or those who like to build or make things... try to make it practical for yourself. Maybe use Biblegateway and compare translations.

V8 What is Paul's command?

V11 I- Who was circumcised? What did it represent? Did it save?

New Testament Christians are no longer under the Old Testament Law, and circumcision is no longer required. This is brought out in a number of New Testament passages, among which are Acts 15; Galatians 2:1–3; 5:1–11; 6:11–16; 1 Corinthians 7:17–20; Colossians 2:8–12; and Philippians 3:1–3. As these passages proclaim, being delivered from our sins is the result of faith in Christ; it is Christ's finished work on the cross that saves, not the observance of an external rite. Even the Law acknowledged that circumcision alone was insufficient to please God, who specified the need to "circumcise your hearts" (Deuteronomy 10:16; cf. Romans 2:29). In salvation, the works of the flesh accomplish nothing (see Galatians 2:16). Got questions

What **interpretive** ideas come to your mind... what do you want to know more about? (after the questions, look in your study bible to begin finding the answers) What **application** can you see here... Is there a...command to obey, promise to claim and trust, challenge to heed, action or attitude to take or change, truth to believe, something or someone to pray about, something to worship and thank God for or relationship I need to work on?
