## Tithes & Offerings

If you have prayed to God about your generosity this past week, & you've responded to Him, thank you for being a believer in Jesus Christ who is literally putting their blessings where your mouth is. You're not just talking to God about living by faith, you're doing it.

Today consider this question: Why do you think we talk so openly about generosity?

Is it because God needs your money? No.

Is it because we're trying to make you uncomfortable? No.

Here is why: We love talking about what God says in His Word. When it comes to generosity, God has a lot to say in Scripture, so we should seek His help as we want to respond to Him.

We hope you'll live in increasing obedience to what God says in His Word about salvation, wisdom, decision making, Godly living, & yes, also what He says about giving.

There is blessing in obedience for you. But there is also blessing in it for others as well.

In the final book of the Old Testament the prophet **Malachi** says in chapter **3** verse **10**, **"Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this," says the Lord Almighty, "and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it."**

When we obey what God says about giving, we are blessed. Ask anyone who has tithed consistently, prioritizing God by giving the first & best of their income, & they'll tell you. When we give like that, God opens up blessings that are not available any other way.

And as God's people respond to Him individually, then the whole church is blessed & so is the community & the world we are ministering to. This is God's plan for our good & His glory.

Let's commit to continue to ask Him for guidance in giving & respond to Him as He speaks.
