
Colossians: The Supremacy of Christ

Our Adult Summer Community Group is a study in the Bible from the Book of Colossians, meeting Wednesday nights @ 6:45p.

Colossians was written by the apostle Paul to teach the Colossian church that Jesus is all they need to experience the fullness of God. Someone had infiltrated the church & was deceiving them into thinking that they needed to add Jewish rituals, harsh treatment of their body, & mystical experiences to really know & experience God. Paul reminds them that Jesus Himself is the very fullness of God & that in Him they have been made complete. If they have Jesus, they already have experienced the fullness of God. They don't need all those other things. Entering into a relationship with Jesus reconciled them to God & gave them a brand-new identity. Now they are the people of God, & they can live the way God created them to live.

Colossians 2 ⁸ Be careful that no one takes you captive through philosophy and empty deceit based on human tradition, based on the elemental forces of the world, and not based on Christ. ⁹ For the entire fullness of God's nature dwells bodily in Christ, ¹⁰ and you have been filled by Him, who is the head over every ruler and authority.

For I am with you"—the declaration of the Lord of Hosts. ⁵ "This is the promise I made to you when you came out of Egypt, and My Spirit is present among you; don't be afraid."
