

To Start Off:

1. What are some causes of the suffering you see in the world today?
2. How is Christian suffering separate and distinct from other types of suffering we endure?

Go Deeper:

Read 1 Peter 4:12-19

3. In what situation should we not expect to suffer? When we do suffer in those situations, how should we respond?
4. Why would Peter have wanted the Christians to not be surprised by suffering for their faith? Why would he want them to rejoice? How is rejoicing in suffering possible?
5. Should our suffering influence the decisions we make? What has happened in our hearts when we make choices to avoid hardship rather than to do right when doing right causes hardship?

7. How might your rejoicing in suffering lead others to see the glory of Christ and want to learn more about Him?
