CELL GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

GET-TO-KNOW

1. Take turns to give a brief life update – one good, one bad, and one ‘what I think God has been up to in my life’.

FROM THE SERMON

2. Can you collectively think of more biblical examples that shows God working through closed doors rather than open ones?

3. What are some open and closed doors you have experienced in your life? Has there been any open doors that turned out to be false, or closed doors that ended up leading you to a promised land?

4. Name a door that has been closed on you during this season. What would it look like for you to breakthrough it? To go elsewhere from it?

BEYOND THE SERMON

5. Read Deuteronomy 1-3 this week (and/or Numbers 10-14). Israelites had a chance to enter the Promised Land only a year after the Exodus. Yet they caused the 40 years of wilderness upon themselves by disobedience then a delayed attempt to obey – they didn’t go into the land because they feared the occupants, then went into the land to fight when God specifically told them not to afterwards. Is there any disobedience or delayed obedience in your life you should rid of?
