CELL GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

GET-TO-KNOW

1. Take turns to give one-minute life update – one good, one bad, and one ‘what I think God has been up to in my life’.

FROM THE SERMON

2. When Deuteronomy 7:6 calls Israel ‘holy’, what does it mean and what is the textual purpose of its holiness?

3. According to the speaker, Americans have the unique lens of ‘ownership’ in life. How can that be a hindrance if we are to be a people chosen by God to be holy as Israelites?

4. According to the speaker, who are the gods that we are warned not to serve lest we commit idolatry? Can you see that happening in your life right now? Perhaps in what particular areas or moments?

BEYOND THE SERMON

5. If you identified an area or two in Question 4 – what would it take for you to serve God instead? Would you need practical plan, tangible goal/commitment, community support, or works of prayer? Seek it out this week. If you could not identify an area or two in Question 4 – what are some forces of the culture that hinder you from living a life owned by God? How can you be less affected by them?
