GET-TO-KNOW

1. Read the Messiah Poem (2:6-11) together. Remember that all sections of Philippians are tethered to this poem to show what it is like to participate in the story of Jesus in one's own life.

2. How would you say that you are participating in the Jesus story in your life? In what areas are you doing well, and in what areas are you not?

3. How do you deal with suffering and pain? How can you be more content in difficulties so that you can better participate in the Jesus story?

4. How can your perspective change to view comfort and convenience as trash, something you need to learn to be content in just like suffering and pain?

BEYOND THE SERMON

5. Spend this week reflecting on the true meaning of Philippians 4:13. Pray, journal, and/or share with a partner about your experience of learning to be content in all circumstances to participate in the story of Jesus.
