
Jesus is Greater, Part 3

1. What is the “therefore” referring to in Hebrews 3:1?
2. According to the speaker, what is the underlying logic of Hebrews 3:3 observed from Hebrews 3:4?
3. According to the speaker, what are the three categories used by the text to claim Jesus as being greater than Moses?
4. According to the speaker, why does the author deploy the comparative literary device Qal-Va-Homer?



CELL GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

GET-TO-KNOW

1. Have a little GOAT (the Greatest of All Time) debate: 1) fast food restaurant, 2) basketball player, 3) musician or music album.

FROM THE SERMON

2. The speaker claimed that Moses is often considered the GOAT mediator of Israel. Why do you think that is?

3. The speaker argued that the text says Jesus is greater than Moses in three categories: capability (on behalf of God), relationship (with God), and function (for God). We can translate these as what resources we have for God, how we are engaging God regularly, and what we are doing currently for God. What does your life look like in these categories?

4. What does it look like to carefully consider (katanoeo) Jesus in suffering? In celebration? In apathy?

BEYOND THE SERMON

5. Jesus is the greatest mediator between humanity and God because He lovingly understands our temptations and sufferings. Is there someone in your life that Jesus is asking you to do the same for? Pray for reach out this week.
