



CELL GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

As your group time begins, use this section to introduce the topic of discussion.

- When do you find it most difficult to love others? When do you find it the easiest?
- If you are a follower of Jesus, how does this inform your efforts to love others?

Read John 13: 1- 17

1. How hard do you find it to love those who do not love you in return?

2. What did the speaker mention two truths we must recognize and fight our lack of love? What are the two truths and why do we need to recognize them?

3. The Speaker asks for two applications:

- a. To pursue love, begin with repentance
- b. To pursue love, constantly gaze at Christ

Considering the speaker's application, how does recognizing the way Christ has loved us help change your perspective on loving others?
