### 5. Prime Christmas Party | Dec 12



### GET-TO-KNOW

1. Briefly share with one another how you spent Thanksgiving weekend.

### FROM THE SERMON

2. As a covenant assumes a communal rather than an individualistic relationship, how can we make our faith more communal than individualistic?

3. The new covenant is better than the old because it is closer (written in people's hearts rather than tablets) and wider (available directly for everyone rather than via priestly system). What are some things we can do to better live it out?

4. The new covenant is transformational rather than transactional – God has committed Himself to loving us whether we uphold our end of the bargain. How does that make you feel?

### BEYOND THE SERMON

5. Is Jesus truly greater in your life? Reflect and identify one or two things that you may have been holding on to more than Jesus. Select an accountability partner within your cell group and meet up for coffee to share.
