### GET-TO-KNOW

### FROM-THE-SERMON

1. Read Titus 3 together. What are some observations you have about the text?
2. Why do you think Paul called on Titus to “remind” the congregation of the series of imperatives in Titus 3:1-3?
3. In Titus 3:3, Paul asks the Cretans to remember their former life. What “former life” is he referring to? Take a moment to put Paul’s description of life before Christ in your own words. If the Apostle Paul would have asked you to remember your life before Christ, what kinds of things would you list?
4. Read Titus 4-7. What has God done in your life? How important is it to know that “God is our Savior”?
5. We are saved in order to do good. What (is) has God done in your life that you would like to encourage and share with others?
