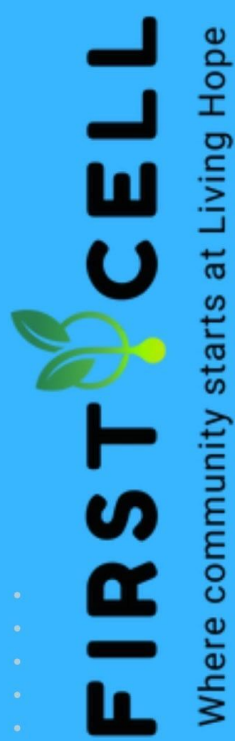

- 2) According to the speaker, why does the circumcision party’s criticism of Peter show human tendency to judge others? (v.1-3 / v.6-9)
- 3) According to the speaker, how does the circumcision party still show the church being a community of belonging for everyone? (v.18)
- 4) According to the speaker, how can we belong well to the church despite real frustrations and lingering pain from others? (v.13-17)
