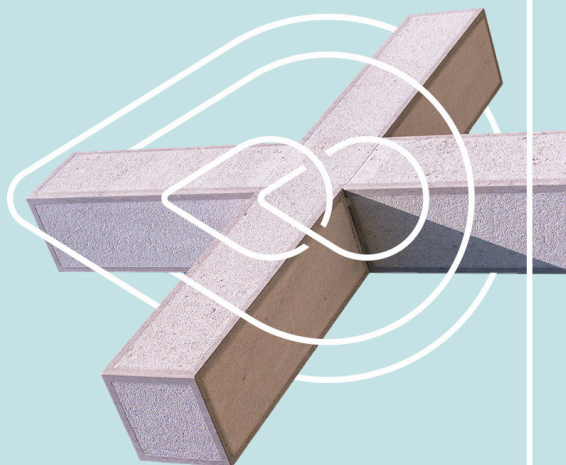

Cell Group Discussion Questions

Get to Know

1. Share any personal experiences or understanding of the Holy Spirit. What comes to mind when you think about the Holy Spirit?

From the Sermon

2. Take turns reading John 14:15-31 and John 16:4-15 aloud. Pay attention to repeated themes, promises, and descriptions of the Holy Spirit.
3. What is the broader context of these passages in the Gospel of John? Why do you think Jesus emphasizes the coming of the Holy Spirit during these specific moments?
4. Jesus speaks of his relationship with the Holy Spirit in confusing ways (e.g. John 14:16, 18, 28). Many would describe this as a teaching on the Trinity. Why is the theology of the Trinity important for Christians to understand and accept?
5. According to these passages, what roles does the Holy Spirit fulfill?
6. Jesus calls the Holy Spirit the Helper in 14:26 and 16:7. This word is often translated as comforter or advocate. In what ways is can the Holy Spirit be a comforter or advocate?

Beyond the Sermon

7. In smaller groups, spend time praying that the Holy Spirit would minister to each person.
