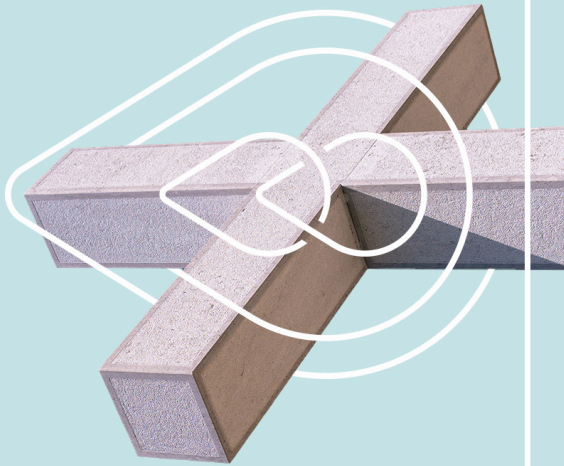

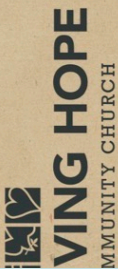

## Cell Group Discussion Questions

### Get to Know

1. Have you ever experienced or witnessed hostility or opposition because of your Christian faith or beliefs? If not, have you ever had to mute your Christian faith or beliefs because you feared hostility or opposition from your friends, family, work, or other community?

### From the Sermon

2. Read John 15:18-16:4a together and pay attention to the word world. Who is the world that Jesus is referring to for the first listeners and who is the world to the readers/listeners of today?
3. Reflecting on Jesus' words in John 15:18-20, why do you think the world's response to Jesus and his followers is one of hatred rather than acceptance or even indifference?
4. The speaker referenced James 4:4 and talked about how a lack of hostility from the world to the church could be an indication that the church has become friends with the world. Would you agree with this assertion? If so, how have you seen this in the church and culture?
5. Jesus warns the church in John 16:1 of falling away. How have you seen the antagonism of the world cause you to fall away in small ways?

### Beyond the Sermon

6. What are some key insights or practical applications you can draw from Jesus' teachings in John 15:18-16:4 to help you navigate challenges and opposition as a follower of Christ in today's world? Pray for wisdom and strength.
