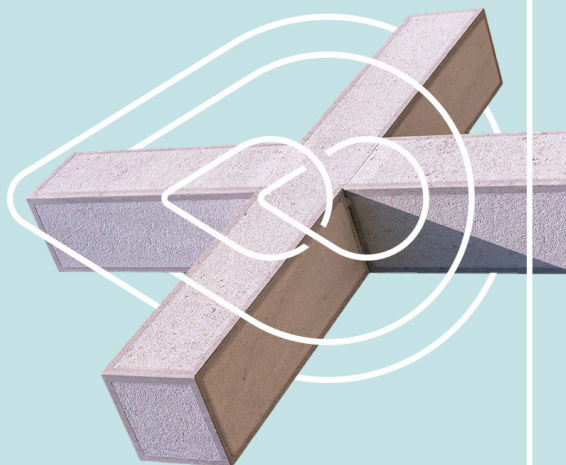

Cell Group Discussion Questions

Get to Know

1. Reflect on a time when you experienced joy after a period of sorrow or difficulty. How did that experience shape your understanding of joy?

From the Sermon

2. Read John 16:16-33 together and look for the Essential Words mentioned in the sermon. Which ones stand out to you and encourage you?
3. Jesus mentions sorrow turning into joy. How do you interpret this concept in the context of the passage?
4. Discuss the concept of praying in Jesus’ name. How does the assurance that the Father loves us and hears our prayers impact your approach to prayer?
5. Consider the disciples’ response when Jesus asks if they now believe. How does their understanding of Jesus align with your own beliefs? In what ways has your faith in Jesus evolved over time?

Beyond the Sermon

6. Reflect on the statement, “Peace comes through faith in Jesus.” How does your faith impact the level of peace you experience in your daily life?
7. Discuss practical ways to deepen your faith and trust in Jesus during challenging times. How can your small group support and encourage one another in this journey?
8. Take a moment to pray together, thanking God for His promises of joy, love, and peace. Lift up any specific challenges or sorrows within the group, asking for God’s guidance and presence in those situations.
